Preamble

The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race in Sailaway starts December 26th 2024

The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race in Sailaway is organized by the the E-sailing Downunder Yacht Club, E.D.Y.C

For Sailaway the E-sailing Downunder Yacht Club, E.D.Y.C set up races in divisions for all Sailaway monohulls that meet the minimum LOA of 21 feet all race courses have a length of 622 nautical miles.

- 1. THE RACE
 - 1.1. The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race will be conducted using the virtual sailing game Sailaway in its latest installment
 - 1.2. The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race will start on December 26th 2024 with the preparation signal of the first race at 01:20 PM local , 2024-12-25 02:20 UTC and start at 01:20 PM local, 2024-12-26 02:30 UTC
 - 1.3. The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race will be conducted in separate divisions by sail mode and boat class and skipper group. Divisions will be announced in the Sailaway simulator, E.D.Y.C Discord server, and on the The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race in Sailaway website.
- 2. SCHEDULE

2.1.	Races will start as following:	
	38" Sailaway Cruiser	at startline A at 01:30 PM
	Folkboat Division	at startline A at 02:00 PM
	40 - 59ft LOA	at startline B at 01:30 PM
	21 - 39ft LOA	at startline B at 02:00 PM
	90+ feet LOA	at startline C at 01:30 PM
	60-90 ft LOA	at startline C at 01:30 PM



- 2.2. Starts may be postponed to a start time later that same day, without further notice.
- 2.3. There may be more races than mentioned in NOR 2.1 without further notice.
- 2.4. Races will be published in Sailaway more than 48 hrs before the preparatory signal.
- 3. COURSE
 - 3.1. The course for The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race is from the start line near Sydney to a separation mark and on to the finish line in Hobart. There are no further marks.
 - 3.2. Courses will be published on Sailaway, however can be changed up to 1 hr before the start.
- 4. AMENDMENTS

This Notice of Race can be amended. Amendments will be published on the Sailaway Discord server and/or the race website

- 5. REGISTRATION
 - 5.1. Boats shall subscribe up to 24 hrs before the start of the race.
 - 5.2. Boats shall have signed in / gone to the start 30 minutes before the start of the race.
 - 5.3. Boats that are late shall explicitly not appear in the start area before 10 minutes AFTER the start of the race.
 - 5.4. Non compliant boats shall be removed from registration at discretion of the race organizers



6. RULES

- 6.1. Documents, or links to public locations of those documents, governing The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race will be published on the Sailaway Discord server and are available for download from The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race website. <u>https://e-offshore-racing.com/index.php/sydney-hobart/</u>
- 6.2. The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race is governed by the rules as defined in Sailing World Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Sailing Instructions (SI) for The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race to be published no later than 14 days before the start of Leg1.
- 6.3. By registering to participate in The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race, e-sailors accept the rules and terms of the race as set out in this Notice of Race and set out in The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race Sailing Instructions.
- 6.4. If an e-sailor behaves in a way that contradicts the rules and terms of engagement set out in this Notice of Race, or those set out in The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race Sailing Instructions. The Race Organizer has the right to remove the e-sailor.
- 6.5. Individual e-sailors are not allowed more than one boat per Skipper Alias to participate in the race.



7. BOAT CLASS

- 7.1. The race will be conducted in the Folkboat, 38" Cruiser, and monohulls with a minimum LOA of 21 feet.
- 8. CLASS DIVISIONS
 - 8.1. Folkboat Div I first 24 registered.8.1.1. Folkboat rating set at 0.624
 - 8.2. 38" Cruiser Division Div I first 24 registered8.2.1. 38" Cruise rating set at 1.280
 - 8.3. Boats with LOA > 21 feet 39 feet8.3.1. Individual Rating TBD based on average polar in Sailaway III
 - 8.4. Boats with LOA > 40 feet 59 feet8.4.1. Individual Rating TBD based on average polar in Sailaway III
 - 8.5. Boats with LOA > 60 89 feet8.5.1. Individual Rating TBD based on average polar in Sailaway III
 - 8.6. Boats with LOA > 90 feet8.6.1. Individual Rating TBD based on average polar in Sailaway III



POINTS

- 8.7. Folkboat and 38' Cruiser races are scored by low points As per Sailing World Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 8.8. Overall and other divisions are sored by corrected time by applying a Time Correcting Factor based on Sailaway Rating
- 9. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
 - 9.1. There is no age restriction on registering for The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race. If an e-sailor under the age of 18 years old qualifies for prices, any prices must be accepted by a parent or legal guardian who must consent to the event rules and the acceptance of the prices.

10. MEDIA RIGHTS

10.1. By participating in an event of The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race, e-sailors automatically grant to the organizers, Sailaway developers Orbcreation b.v and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any live, taped or filmed reproductions, in game video streams and of the e-sailor during the period of The Sydney Hobart Yacht Race without compensation.
